**21 Brown’s Brook Allotments**

It was reported that a productive meeting had been held with the Brown’s Brook Allotment Association and the Land Agent (notes of the meeting were circulated)

**22 Cardio Pulmonary exercise benches**

The Chairman reported that she had been unable to arrange a meeting with Teignbridge District Council officers. It was agreed to defer arranging a meeting of the working party pending approval of the Pay Park on the Lawn and the Cycle Track.

**23 Dawlish Museum Notice Board at the Waterfowl Pen**

Cofton Hill, Cockwood

Path off Summerlands Avenue, Dawlish (Path 41)

Close to railway bridges, Coastguard Cottages and Rockstone for example

Country lanes coming into Dawlish

Elm Grove Road

Newlands

The Town Centre
