I am sorry to say that this year has not fulfilled the ambition of the Council to have a NP made. In spite of the Council giving the Committee financial backing to prepare a plan to go out to consultation, and finding a planner prepare to help with work we were not able to get enough members of the public to join the committee. A great deal of work had been achieved towards our aims but for this plan to be “made” it has to be own by residents who would also be responsible, with the Council’s help, to make certain that the goals in the plan were implemented. After a lengthy debate and a great deal of thought it was decided that the project would be looked at again when a new council takes over after 2 May 2019. The financial implications now are that there is uncertainty over where the CIL monies by the time the plan is made will still be there, but it would give Dawlish a say in how developments take place, as long as they are in accordance with the Local Plan. We continue to have 15% of present CIL monies which will be spent on projects that benefit residents.
